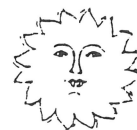

COLD OR COOL WEATHER PLANTS GROW WELL IN SPRING OR FALL

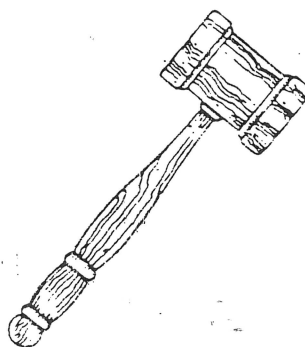
WARM OR HOT WEATHER PLANTS GROW BEST IN THE SUMMER

HOURS OF SUNLIGHT NEEDED FOR DIFFERENT PLANTS

- 4 hours LEAFY GREENS (lettuce, mustard, spinach, collards, cabbage, chard)
- 6 hours ROOT CROPS (carrots, beets, radishes, turnips, rutabagas, parsnips, potatoes)
- 8 hours FRUIT CROPS (tomatoes, peppers, squash, melons, eggplant, cucumbers, corn)

COMPANION PLANTING ... certain plants grow well together. They protect each other from bugs or disease. Also certain herbs and flowers are helpful to grow around your vegetables. They produce odors that repel some bugs.

- BEANS LIKE CORN, CABBAGE, CUCUMBERS, POTATOES
- BEETS LIKE ONIONS AND TURNIPS
- CABBAGE LIKES POTATOES, ONIONS BEETS,
- CARROTS LIKE LETTUCE, TOMATOES AND ONIONS
- CORN LIKES CUCUMBERS, SQUASH, BEANS, SUNFLOWERS AND PUMPKINS
- CUCUMBERS LIKE CORN, SUNFLOWERS
- EGGPLANT LIKES PEPPERS
- LETTUCE LIKES RADISHES AND OTHER GREENS
- POTATOES LIKE CORN, CABBAGE, AND BEANS
- PUMPKINS LIKE CORN
- TOMATOES LIKE PEPPERS, CARROTS, AND CABBAGE
