

**Minutes of the Roselawn Community Council Members Meeting
October 9, 2008**

Barbara Kley, President, called the meeting to order at 7:30. Guests were invited to stand and introduce themselves. Those that did were: Judy Luebbers, a judge running for election; Vernon Ford, resident at 7948 Greenland; Paulette Phillips, a new resident on Eastlawn; Anisha, business owner of Capital Logic which can help with credit problems; Josh Krekler, Pleasant Ridge resident who spoke about Issue 8 for the upcoming election.

Fire Report: Troy Davenport reported that there were 107 runs made in the past month; 16 fire, 45 non-fire, 6 1 alarm fires, 1 extra alarm fire. The Fire Department completes between 2300-2400 annual inspections. They have completed about 90 % of their inspections for this year. The wind storm on September 14th affected the local fire department. Their main power was out from that Sunday to that Thursday. The Cincinnati Fire Department made over 800 runs in the city that Sunday alone.

Police Reports: Officer Barry acknowledged residents' concern over the high number of burglaries that have been committed. Citizens on Patrol is a way for residents to help control crime in their neighborhood. Members of Citizens on Patron represent the police department. While on patrol, members carry a radio which allows for direct contact with the Police Department. There must be at least 2 members to walk. Training is required to become a member of Citizens on Patrol.

Recycling Program: Roy Jones brought a few recycling bins to pass out to residents. The city-wide contest for recycling participation is still going on. The prize for the winning neighborhood is \$250.

Roselawn Business Association: The next Business Meeting will be held Monday, October 20, 12 noon at the Dukester. Lunch will be available (\$8.00 per person). All are welcome.
